

Northbound 101 On-Ramp Loop Closed Until March 17

The three-week closure of the northbound loop on-ramp to the 101 freeway is currently underway. The ramp is being temporarily closed to ensure the safety of both motorists and construction crew members during this phase of the bridge reconstruction project.

The ramp will be re-opened by 5:00 pm on Monday, March 17. The other on-ramp (from southbound Lindero Canyon Road, below the Four Seasons Hotel) to the northbound 101 freeway from Lindero Canyon Road is open for travel. In addition, motorists may choose to access the 101 freeway from either Reyes Adobe Road in Agoura Hills or Westlake Boulevard in Thousand Oaks as an alternative to Lindero Canyon Road. The entire bridge reconstruction project is still on target for completion by the end of October 2014.

The 20th annual Westlake Village Rotary Street Fair will be held on Sunday, April 6. This popular community event, hosted by the Rotary Club of Westlake Village, will be held on Lakeview Canyon Road between Agoura and Lake Harbor Roads.

All proceeds raised by the Rotary Club of Westlake Village will support local charities. Residents that attend the annual event will enjoy musical entertainment, food vendors, art and craft displays, and fun activities for children. The Street Fair is open from 10 am to 5 pm.

Drought Conditions Call for Water Reducing Measures

As many residents are aware, the current drought conditions are the worst in recorded history. In response, Governor Brown has proclaimed a "State of Emergency" in regards to taking action in dealing with the drought. To help prepare residents for potential water reduction practices, the Las Virgenes Municipal Water District recently enacted the following water restriction measures.

- Watering of landscapes is prohibited between the hours of 10 am and 5 pm.
- Check for and fix broken or mis-aimed sprinklers. This practice can help to prevent overwatering and conserves water that may have been inadvertently watering a sidewalk, wall, or neighbor's yard.
- Residents are encouraged to turn off their sprinklers during a rainstorm and to keep them off for 24 hours following rainfall of an inch or more.
- The washing down of sidewalks, parking areas, and driveways is not permitted.
- A nozzle that can stop and start the flow of water is required on hoses used for home car washing.
