FREE TROLLEY SERVICE TO NEIGHBORHOODS, RESTAURANTS AND SHOPS IN WESTLAKE VILLAGE


The "Village Trolley" is an exciting new nine-week pilot-program that will provide free transportation between Westlake Village neighborhoods, retail areas, and restaurants. The trolley will operate on Friday and Saturday nights from 4:00 – 11:00 pm beginning July 4 through August 30.

Riding the "Village Trolley" is easy. Simply hop on at one of fifteen stops listed below and hop off whenever you want. The trolley is outfitted with a GPS locator device allowing riders to use their smartphone to track the trolley's progress. The trolley is not just transportation. On numerous nights and times, the City will provide free entertainment on the trolley to make your ride that much more enjoyable. Check the City website for the up-to-date entertainment schedule. The "Village Trolley" is the perfect way to get to TGIF at the Civic Center and Saturday Concerts in the Park. A special Berniece Bennett Park pick-up/drop-off will be offered on July 26 and August 9 to coincide with those events.

Shoppes at Westlake Village to Open in July

Later this month, residents can look forward to the opening of the new retail shopping center on Russell Ranch Road. The Shoppes at Westlake Village was approved by the City Council in May of 2012 and has been under construction for the past year. Final improvements for the first phase are wrapping up and preparations for a grand opening are being made. Construction on the second phase has already begun.

The anchor tenant, Target, is scheduled to open on July 27. Other businesses in the shopping center will open just before or soon after the Target opening. These include Tilly's, Total Woman Gym and Spa, Hook Burger, Jeannine's Market, The Gallery Seafood and Chophouse, Los Agaves Mexican Restaurant, Olio e Limone Italian Restaurant and Olio Pizzeria and Enoteca, Greens Up!, Endless Beauty Supply, and Suite Vibes Salon. In-N-Out Burger is also under construction and is anticipated to open by the end of 2014.

Lindero Canyon Bridge Reconstruction Project Update

The Lindero Canyon bridge project is over 50% complete. Most of the work on the east side of the bridge is finished and includes a new pedestrian walkway, barrier walls, new landscaping, and exterior mural. Work has now shifted to the west side of the bridge.

In addition to new barrier walls and fencing on the west side, creation of an exterior mural identical to the east side mural will take place. Recent construction of the west side has occurred at night; however contractors will begin daytime work shortly. Residents are asked to drive with caution and care in this active construction area. It is anticipated that the west side phase of construction will be completed in August. The final phase, which will include removal of the center median and re-alignment of the travel lanes, is scheduled to begin in early September with the entire project anticipated to be completed by the end of October.
