### ESCAPE TO NATURE WITH BOOKS! 2015 “WESTLAKE VILLAGE READS” TO FEATURE SEVEN EXCITING PROGRAMS

During the months of January and February, the City of Westlake Village, the Westlake Village Library, and the Friends of the Westlake Village Library are co-sponsoring the 6<sup>th</sup> annual “Westlake Village Reads”, a One-City-One-Book program. This year’s theme, “Escape to Nature with Books!” will be presented through seven programs for residents of all ages.

The program kicks off with an astronomy program called “Westlake Village Under the Stars” on Sunday, January 4 at 5:00 pm. Additional programs include a live animal program, master gardener program, nature photography class, natural and recycled art, and a guided family hike through Wildwood Regional Park. All programs are free and open to the public. Every program with the exception of February 22 will be held in the Westlake Village Community Rooms at 31200 Oak Crest Drive.

The Library will display a variety of “Nature” themed books including both adult and children book titles. Residents are encouraged to select titles that fit their personal interests throughout the two-month program. The Friends’ *Book Nook* will be creating a special “Nature” section for residents that wish to purchase a book to read along with the program.
