PLAY BALL!

The First Phase of the Westlake Village Community Park Now Open to the Public

On April 11, the City held a ceremony to officially open the first phase of the new Westlake Village Community Park. At the event, City officials were joined by representatives from Westlake Agoura Girls Softball, Westlake Pony Baseball, and AYSO Region 4, along with representatives from the Triunfo YMCA. Following the ceremony, teams from Westlake Agoura Girls Softball and Westlake Pony Baseball played their first official games at the new facility. Residents of all ages enjoyed this special evening as they watched the ball games, explored the new Park, and were treated to some amazing views.

The new Park currently offers two lighted synthetic turf baseball/softball fields with an overlay soccer field, the first segment of the walking/jogging trail, an outdoor basketball court, volleyball court, and picnic facilities. Completion of the restroom and concession facility is expected by the end of

April. Future phases will include an additional lighted synthetic turf softball/baseball field and three soccer fields, landscaping, final segments of the walking/jogging trail, fitness stations, two tot play areas, and a trail head. The skateboard park is currently under construction and is expected to open to the public in June.

As active construction on the Park continues into the month of May, the Park will be temporarily closed during the weekdays and open on weekends for both drop-in play and reserved use. Information regarding ball field reservations can be found at both the Park and on the City's website. Once construction is complete, the Park will be open daily from 5 am to 10 pm, with the ball fields open until 9 pm. The skateboard park will be open daily from sunrise to sunset. City's Summer Entertainment Series Presents Seven Exciting Events Beginning May 29

The City of Westlake Village kicks off its 12th Season of summer entertainment on May 29. The series begins with "Jazz Night." The multi-award winning jazz bands from both Lindero Canyon Middle School and Agoura High School will be performing. The performance starts at 7:00 pm. "Jersey Dogs" hot dog cart will be on-site offering family friendly dinners for sale.



"Jazz Night" is part of a series of seven special events sponsored by the City of Westlake Village that is geared for the entire family. Upcoming "TGIF" events at the Civic Center include classic "Rodgers and Hammerstein" songs including selections from Cabrillo Music Theater's production of "Oklahoma" on June 26, an outdoor movie screening featuring "Despicable Me" and family activities on July 24, and Dixieland Night featuring local band "Riverboat Dixie" on August 7.

In addition to these four events, the City is proud to continue the "Saturdays in the Park" events. This summer concert series will feature three events on Saturday nights at Berniece Bennett Park. The series kicks off on June 13 with "The Long Run," a tribute to "The Eagles." Additional concerts will feature "80Z All Stars," 1980's tribute band on July 18 and "Boogie Knights," a disco tribute concert on August 22. "Saturdays in the Park" concerts begin at 7:00 pm.



The four TGIF events on Friday evenings are held at the Westlake Village Civic Center, 31200 Oak Crest Drive. The three "Saturdays in the Park" events will be held at Berniece Bennett Park, 31800 Village Center Drive. These outdoor performances are free to the public and families are encouraged to attend. Please bring lawn chairs and picnic baskets for these delightful early evening summer performances. As the temperatures drop in the early evening hours, don't forget to bring your sweater or jacket. Food will be available for sale at each event starting at 6:00 pm. Update on Agoura Road Sidewalk Project

After a series of unanticipated contractor related delays, construction of the Agoura Road sidewalk is now fully underway. The project, once completed, will feature a meandering paver style pathway along the south side of Agoura Road between Lindero Canyon and Lakeview Canyon Roads. It is anticipated that the pathway will be finished by Labor Day.

As traffic control devices may be placed in the Agoura Road bike lane and number two lanes near construction activities, cyclists and pedestrians are asked to remain alert while traveling in this area. 
Summer Senior Recreation Program Begins May 18



Public Safety Corner Living with Wildlife

As spring is in full force and summer is almost upon us, residents may notice that coyotes, possums, and snakes are out and about. Areas of open space and homes adjacent to open space may see more of these creatures. Here are a few helpful tips for dealing with the nature in our backyards:



- ☞ Do not leave small pets outdoors unattended.
- ☞ Always monitor small children when outdoors.
- ☞ Do not leave food outdoors.
- ☞ Keep garbage can lids tightly closed.
- ☞ Remove items that animals could use to seek shelter, food, or water.

Aggressive coyote behavior should be reported immediately to the City's Planning Department by calling 818-706-1613. For snake removal, residents should call the fire station at 818-889-1626.
