

Westlake Village Transit Bus Pass Sales Begin on July 25

Residents will once again have the option to avoid traffic delays associated with drop-off/pick-up at White Oak Elementary, Lindero Canyon Middle, and Agoura High Schools by utilizing the Westlake Village Transit service. This City-subsidized program offers stops in all major neighborhoods and the three public schools that serve Westlake Village residents.

An annual round-trip bus pass can be purchased for \$238 and a one-way (morning or afternoon) pass for \$158. Bus passes can be purchased beginning on July 25 in one of three ways: (1) online via the City website and the pass will be mailed to your home; (2) mail-in, forms can be downloaded from the City website (mail-in ends on August 12); or (3) in person at City Hall. Residents may also ride one-way without a bus pass for \$2.00. The first day of school is on Wednesday, August 24, 2016.
