THE 2017 “WESTLAKE VILLAGE READS” DELVES INTO EIGHT MYSTERY THEMED PROGRAMS

During the months of January and February, the City of Westlake Village, the Westlake Village Library, and the Friends of the Westlake Village Library are co-sponsoring the 8th annual “Westlake Village Reads”, a One-City-One-Book program. This year’s theme, “Mystereads” will be presented through eight programs for residents of all ages.

The program kicks off with the “Mysteries of Magic” featuring a magic show from *Labak the Magician* and a magic lesson from local magician Melissa Wolfson on Saturday, January 7 at 2:00 pm. Additional programs include a space program, afternoon with author Lee Goldberg, script analysis teen program, optical illusions for children program, and a mystery into movie screening and trivia afternoon. Every program will be held at the Westlake Village Civic Center located at 31200 Oak Crest Drive.

The Library will display a variety of “Mystery” themed books including both adult and children book titles. Residents are encouraged to select titles that fit their personal interests throughout the two-month program. The Friends’ *Book Nook* will be creating a special “Mystery” section for residents that wish to purchase a book to read along with the program.
