WESTLAKE VILLAGE SUMMER ENTERTAINMENT SERIES PRESENTS SEVEN EXCITING EVENTS BEGINNING JUNE 2

The City of Westlake Village kicks off its 14th Season of summer entertainment on Friday, June 2. The series begins with “Jazz Night.” The multi-award winning jazz bands from both Lindero Canyon Middle School and Agoura High School will be performing. The performance starts at 7:00 pm. “Jersey Dogs” hot dog cart will be on-site offering family friendly dinners for sale.

“Jazz Night” is part of a series of seven special events sponsored by the City of Westlake Village that is geared for the entire family. Upcoming “TGIF” events at the Civic Center include “Stories turned into Musicals: A Song Adventure” featuring selections from Cabrillo Music Theater’s production of “Peter Pan” on June 30 and a musical evening with “Bonnie Bowden” on August 11.

In addition to these three events, the City is proud to continue the “*Saturdays in the Park*” series. This summer entertainment series will feature four events on Saturday nights at Berniece Bennett Park. The Saturday programs kick off on June 17 with “The Police Experience”, a tribute to The Police. Additional concerts will feature “Bella Donna,” a tribute to Stevie Nicks and Fleetwood Mac on July 15 and “Hollywood U2,” a tribute to U2 concert on August 26. “*Saturdays in the Park*” concerts begin at 7:00 pm. The additional Saturday event is a “Movie in the Park” night featuring “Finding Dory” and pre-show activities on July 29. The outdoor movie will begin at approximately 8 pm.

The three TGIF events on Friday evenings are held at the Westlake Village Civic Center, 31200 Oak Crest Drive. The four “*Saturdays in the Park*” events will be held at Berniece Bennett Park, 31800 Village Center Drive. These outdoor performances are free to the public and families are encouraged to attend. Please bring lawn chairs and picnic baskets for these delightful early evening summer performances. Food will be available for sale at each event starting at 6:00 pm.
