

## PUBLIC WORKS UPDATE

Currently, multiple Public Works Department projects are underway including the final phase of work on the Lakeview Canyon Road/Agoura Road decorative crosswalks, the Agoura Road sidewalk lighting, the Westlake Village Community Park, and the new Westlake Village dog park.

### LAKEVIEW CANYON ROAD/AGOURA ROAD DECORATIVE CROSSWALKS

The final phase to complete the decorative crosswalks will begin on July 10 and take approximately 4 weeks. To ensure the safety of motorists and construction crews, a significant amount of traffic control will be required throughout the work area. Please continue to drive with extreme caution or seek alternative routes during the project. ### COMMUNITY PARK UPDATE

Work continues on the final phase of the Westlake Village Community Park. This includes finishing the third baseball field, two tot lots, three soccer fields, two sand volleyball courts and a walking trail. The third baseball field will include the installation of backstops, bleachers and synthetic turf. The new tot lots will feature shade structures, playground equipment and a Parkour course. The smaller tot lot, located next to the baseball fields, will include baseball and softball themed playground equipment. The new soccer area will feature a large turf field that will be divided into three playing fields alongside a gazebo and restroom/concession building. Final landscaping around the park will include a 10-foot wide walking trail approximately one mile in length. Work is anticipated to be completed by late fall.



### NEW DOG PARK OPENING SOON

The new Westlake Village dog park is scheduled to open in late fall of 2017. It will be located near the corner of Oak Crest Drive and Agoura Road. The park will encompass approximately three quarters of an acre with separate areas for large and small dogs. Both include grass and dirt areas. The design of the park includes a shade shelter for park patrons, dog rinse stations, dog play mounds, bench seating and drinking fountains with doggie bowls.

### AGOURA ROAD SIDEWALK LIGHTING

Aesthetic lighting is being added to illuminate the meandering sidewalk from Lakeview Canyon Road to Lindero Canyon Road. This project is expected to be completed by mid-summer.

Please join the 48th Annual 4th of July Parade at the former hospital property at 4415 Lakeview Canyon. The full morning begins at 8:00 am with a pancake breakfast from Boy Scout Troop #752. The parade line-up begins at 9:30 am, and at 9:45 am the short 4-block parade commences to Berniece Bennett Park for inflatable activities, crafts, music, old fashioned park games, free popsicles and water. The driving range at the Westlake Village Golf Course will be open to the public at 5:00 pm with free seating, food trucks, games, and entertainment that will all lead up to the incredible fireworks show at 9:10 pm. Residents may bring a picnic or purchase food from the food vendors. However, please do not bring any outside alcohol to the event. Outside alcohol will NOT be permitted inside the gates. Beer and wine will be available for purchase inside the event. Bags, purses, and coolers will be checked for alcohol upon arrival. Please arrival early to avoid long lines.

The 500-ft. high fireworks display will be viewable from multiple locations throughout the City. Residents may wish to consider a backyard barbeque or block-party prior to the 9:10 pm show. Residents may also pack a picnic and view the fireworks from Calvary Community Church or Berniece Bennett Park. For safety reasons, please stay off the Golf Course property. The parking lot at the golf course is only available for drop offs, however additional parking is available at alternative locations such as the former hospital property.

# WESTLAKE VILLAGE TRANSIT BUS PASS SALES BEGIN ON JULY 24

Residents will once again have the option to avoid traffic delays associated with drop-off/pick-up at White Oak Elementary, Lindero Canyon Middle, and Agoura High Schools by utilizing the Westlake Village Transit service. This City-subsidized program offers stops in all major neighborhoods and the three public schools that serve Westlake Village residents.

An annual round-trip bus pass can be purchased for \$238 and a one-way (morning or afternoon) pass for \$158. Bus passes can be purchased beginning on July 24 in one of three ways: (1) on-line via the City website and the pass will be mailed to your home; (2) mail-in, forms can be downloaded from the City's website (mail-in ends on August 19); or (3) in person at City Hall. Residents may also ride one-way without a bus pass for \$2.00. The first day of school is Wednesday, August 23, 2017.
