The City will also be hosting an Adopt-A-Family Item Collection Program table to gather items needed by the Westlake Village families affected by the Woolsey Fires.

Free activities at the event include a cookie and cupcake decorating area, craft and tattoo station, ornament making station, and special giveaways and food samples from participating shops in the center from 3:00 to 6:00 pm. There are multiple opportunities for photos or "elfies" throughout the event including two special guests, Mary Poppins and Bert from "Sing a Song Princess Parties" and Mr. and Mrs. Claus. The activities are free and open to the public while supplies last. The sing-a-long will feature a small choir and band composed of local musicians. In addition, local community leaders and business owners will lead the singing of fun winter tunes. The event will occur rain or shine.
