WESTLAKE VILLAGE READS CELEBRATES 10 YEARS WITH “A DELICIOUS READ: A SECOND COURSE”

The City of Westlake Village, the Westlake Village Library, and Friends of the Westlake Village Library are pleased to co-sponsor the 10th year of Westlake Village Reads, the City's version of a One City One Book Program. The 2019 Westlake Village Reads program will focus on a main theme rather than a single book. This year's theme is "A Delicious Read: A Second Course." Westlake Village Reads will host a special 2-day event with programs for all ages on February 9 and 10 at the Westlake Village Civic Center. If you like food, eating, history, and learning about food, Westlake Village is the place to be in February. As part of the food theme, the City is partnering with the Manna Food Bank to collect canned foods and residents are encouraged to bring a donation while attending each program.
