### WESTLAKE VILLAGE SUMMER ENTERTAINMENT SERIES PRESENTS SEVEN EXCITING EVENTS BEGINNING MAY 31

The City of Westlake Village kicks off its 16<sup>th</sup> season of summer entertainment on Friday, May 31. The series begins with “Jazz Night.” The multi-award winning jazz bands from both Lindero Canyon Middle School and Agoura High School will be performing at 7:00pm. Food truck service and sales will begin starting at 5:30 pm.

Please join the City for a “Welcome Reception” to meet the new City Manager Rob de Geus from 5:00 pm to 6:30 pm in the Community Rooms behind the stage area.

“Jazz Night” is part of a series of seven special events sponsored by the City of Westlake Village that is geared for the entire family. Upcoming “TGIF” events at the Civic Center include “Classics Night” *a night of musical theatre song performances from classics like West Side Story with 5-STAR THEATRICALS* on June 28, and a 1920s’, 30s’ and 40s’ musical evening with “Dutch Newman and the Musical Melodians” on August 9.

In addition to these three events, the City is proud to continue its “Saturdays in the Park” series. This summer entertainment series will feature four events on Saturday nights at Berniece Bennett Park. The Saturday programs kick off on June 15 with the “Platinum Groove Motown Soul Band”. Additional concerts will feature “Fantastic Diamond,” a tribute to *Neil Diamond Concert* on July 13 and “Colour My World” *a tribute to Chicago Concert* on August 24. “Saturdays in the Park” concerts begin at 7:00 pm. Food trucks will begin serving at 5:30pm. The additional Saturday event is a “Movie in the Park” night on July 27, featuring “Disney’s Moana” and pre-show activities like Captain Carl’s Mobile Tidepool. The outdoor movie will begin at approximately 8 pm.

The three “TGIF” events on Friday evenings are held at the Westlake Village Civic Center, 31200 Oak Crest Drive. The four “Saturdays in the Park” events will be held at Berniece Bennett Park, 31800 Village Center Drive. These outdoor performances are free to the public and families are encouraged to attend. Please bring lawn chairs, blankets, and picnic baskets for these early evening summer performances. Food will be available for sale at each event starting at 5:30 pm.
