CITY OF WESTLAKE VILLAGE TO DEDICATE THE LINDERO LINEAR PARK PROJECT

On Wednesday, September 25 at 4:00 pm, the City of Westlake Village will host a dedication ceremony commemorating the completion of the Lindero Linear Park Project. The newly designed sidewalk features a meandering walkway, water efficient plants and vines, new trees, and several environmental bio-swales to help clean storm water that flows to the storm drains and eventually the ocean. The new plants and vines will help to screen the existing flood control channel and adjacent homes from the walkway and the street. In addition, the new sidewalk creates new spaces and a wider pathway that can accommodate wheelchairs, strollers, dog walkers, and joggers. Funding for the project was provided by Metro, a partner in our Community. Metro is a transportation planner, funder, builder and operator for the country's most populous county. The Agency provides resources to improve quality of life in LA County by partnering with communities to fund local projects.

The ceremony will feature comments from the Mayor of Westlake Village, City Engineer Jessica Arden, and Los Angeles County Metropolitan Authority. The dedication ceremony is open to the public. We encourage everyone to take an afternoon stroll through the beautiful new project.

The ribbon cutting ceremony will take place on the new sidewalk near the large stairway and bench area across from the Baronsgate Road and Lindero Canyon Road intersection. Please park along Rustic Oak Drive or Blue Meadow Lane to safely walk to ceremony location.
