OAK TREE PERMIT NO. 20-006

The City Council of the City of Westlake Village will conduct a public hearing to consider an application from Martha Martins, requesting approval of an Oak Tree Permit (OTP) No. 20-006, authorizing the removal of three decaying and dying coast live oak trees and the pruning of one coast live oak tree located at 62 Robin Hood Lane.

The Public Hearing will be held via teleconference, in accordance with Governor Newsom's Executive Order N-29-20, at 6:30 p.m., Wednesday, May 13, 2020. Testimony regarding the proposed project may be presented at that time.

The proposed project is exempt from the provisions of the California Environmental Quality Act as a Class 4 Categorical Exemption. Challenges to the proposed project in court may be limited to only those issues raised at the public hearing described in this notice, or in written correspondence delivered to the City at, or prior to, the public hearing.
