PLANNED DEVELOPMENT PERMIT NO. 20-003

The City Council of the City of Westlake Village will conduct a public hearing to consider an application from the John S. Adamick Family Trust, requesting approval of Planned Development Permit (PDP) No. 20-003, authorizing an interior remodel of an existing single-family residence that includes the conversion of 1,792 sq. ft. of existing non-habitable attic space into habitable living space located at 3840 Mainsail Circle.

The Public Hearing will be held via teleconference, in accordance with Governor Newsom's Executive Order N-29-20, at 6:30 p.m., Wednesday, July 8, 2020 in the City Council Chambers located at 31200 Oak Crest Drive, Westlake Village, California. Testimony regarding the proposed project may be presented at that time.

The proposed project is exempt from the provisions of the California Environmental Quality Act. Challenges to the proposed project in court may be limited to only those issues raised at the public hearing described in this notice, or in written correspondence delivered to the City at, or prior to, the public hearing.
