

RESOLUTION NO. 2139-20

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL
OF THE CITY OF WESTLAKE VILLAGE, CALIFORNIA,
MAKING APPOINTMENTS TO TWO CITY COUNCIL OFFICES AND CANCELLING THE
NOVEMBER 3, 2020 GENERAL MUNICIPAL ELECTION

WHEREAS, as of the close of the nomination period on August 7, 2020, there are not more candidates than City Council offices to be elected at the November 3, 2020 general municipal election; and

WHEREAS, Elections Code Section 10229 allows one of the following courses of action to be taken by the City Council:

1. Appoint to the office the person who has been nominated.
2. Appoint to the office any eligible voter if no one has been nominated.
3. Hold the election if either no one or only one person has been nominated; and

WHEREAS, a certification of the facts was submitted to the City Council on August 10, 2020, pursuant to Elections Code Section 10229; and

WHEREAS, a notice of these facts and the courses of action available was published on August 13, 2020, in a newspaper of general circulation pursuant to Elections Code Section 10229 and Government Code Section 6061.

NOW, THEREFORE, THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF WESTLAKE VILLAGE, CALIFORNIA, does hereby resolve, declare, determine and order as follows:

Section 1. Pursuant to Elections Code Section 10229, the following persons are appointed to the offices to which they were nominated:


NAME	OFFICE	TERM
Ned E Davis	Member of the City Council	4 years
Kelly Honig	Member of the City Council	4 years

Section 2. The general municipal election scheduled to be held on Tuesday, November 3, 2020, is canceled.

Section 3. The persons appointed shall qualify and take office and serve exactly as if elected at a municipal election for the office.

Section 4. The City Clerk shall certify to the passage and adoption of this Resolution and enter it into the book of original resolutions.
