Update on City's Arterial System Finance Program



Construction of the next phase of the City's Arterial System Finance Program (ASFP), a long-range improvement program initiated years ago to improve traffic flow along the Lindero Canyon Road corridor from Agoura Road to Thousand Oaks Boulevard, recently commenced with work at the Agoura Road/Lindero Canyon Road intersection. This phase will include installation of two new turn lanes on Agoura Road involving an additional eastbound left turn lane along with a westbound right turn lane, and installation of a new Lindero Canyon Road southbound right turn lane. Coupled with new video detection units to replace the existing roadway loop

detectors, these improvements will enhance the overall operational characteristics and traffic flow at the intersection.

Initial work on this phase occurred in early March with the clearing of shrubbery and trees in the construction area. This will be followed by the installation of new signal poles and modifications to, and expansion of, the existing bridge over the flood control channel at the northeast corner of the intersection. These modifications will allow room for the new dedicated westbound Agoura Road right turn lane. The construction of all intersection improvements is slated to be completed early next fall in October.

Although every effort is being made to stage the work and to utilize all available traffic control measures to minimize traffic impacts during this phase, it is nonetheless likely there will be a degree of inconvenience experienced by motorists using this intersection during the period of construction. While most travel lanes and a temporary bike lane will remain open, the City asks drivers to be mindful of the work and to use extra care, caution and patience while driving in this area.

City to Hold Study Session Regarding Business Park Specific Plan on May 25

On Wednesday, May 25 the City Council will consider several adaptive re-use and redevelopment strategies for an aging business park area located to the north of the Four Seasons Hotel. The May study session is part of a two-year planning effort being conducted by the City with the assistance of The Arroyo Group, a multi-disciplinary consulting firm headquartered in Pasadena. The selected strategies will ultimately form the basis for a long-range plan, called a Specific Plan, covering approximately 84 acres and over 2 million square feet of existing office and business park space. Strategies to be considered include creation of a home design district, live-work districts, and specialty retail areas all linked by a system of plazas, greenbelts, and enhanced streets, sidewalks and bikeways.

A topographic model of the business park area depicting both existing and proposed building configurations has been constructed, and will be available for review and discussion at the May 25 study session. Residents are invited to attend the session, beginning at 4:30 p.m., and offer thoughts and suggestions regarding this forward-looking planning process.

Senior Recreation Program to Begin Online Registration



The City will begin offering online registration for its Senior Recreation Program beginning May 11. Westlake Village residents age 55 and older, may begin registering for the June-July session on May 11. Registration for non-seniors or non-residents will begin on May 26. Mail-in registration will also be available and the full schedule of classes will be printed in the May-July edition of the City's Cultural Recreation Magazine. The Senior Recreation Program is operated under an agreement with the Conejo Recreation and Park District.

Annual City Resurfacing Program Scheduled to Begin in Late April

As part of the City's Annual Street Resurfacing Program, select City streets are designated for maintenance each year. Streets are evaluated individually to determine the appropriate level of maintenance required. The following streets are scheduled for a slurry seal beginning in late April/early May:

- ★ Lakeview Canyon Road;
- ★ Watergate Road between Lakeview Canyon and La Venta Roads; and
- ★ Russell Ranch Road.

Public Safety Corner

Preparing for Emergencies

One of the first steps in disaster preparedness is the creation of a basic disaster supply kit. The LA County Fire Department recommends that all kits contain the following:

- ★ Water - recommended minimum 7-10 day supply (one gallon per person per day)
- ★ Food - recommended minimum 7-10 day supply
- ★ Flashlight
- ★ Portable radio
- ★ Extra batteries
- ★ First Aid Kit including surgical and other protective gloves
- ★ Emergency blanket(s)
- ★ Multi-purpose utility shut-off tool
- ★ Cash
- ★ Toiletries
- ★ Cotton clothing
- ★ Small toolkit
- ★ Prescription glasses
- ★ Prescription medication - seven day supply and prescription
- ★ Coloring books - small activities for children

If you have a pet at home, the following should be included in your disaster supply kit:

- ★ Food, water, and medications - recommended minimum is 7 - 10 day supply of each
- ★ Dishes - for both food and water
- ★ Can opener - for food
- ★ Sanitation - dog baggies, bagged pet litter with pan and scoop
- ★ Collar, ID tags, and leash
- ★ Crates/carrier
- ★ Important information bag - A photo of your pet - license, microchip, and vaccination information along with copies of prescriptions and medical records in a plastic bag in your kit
- ★ Toys, treats, and bedding
