



NOTICE OF PUBLIC MEETING TO CONSIDER CHANGES TO WASTE COLLECTION SERVICES

WHAT'S BEING CONSIDERED:

The Westlake Village City Council will be considering a new agreement with Waste Management (WM) for the continued collection of trash, recyclables, and organic waste in the City of Westlake Village. Under this agreement, WM will continue to be our exclusive waste hauler for residential customers, and will become our exclusive waste hauler for commercial customers over the next five years.

This agreement will reduce rates for most customers and create consistency across the City while incorporating an organic waste recycling program to comply with new State law, Senate Bill 1383.

AFTER EXTENSIVE NEGOTIATIONS, THE FOLLOWING SERVICES ARE BEING CONSIDERED:

Services That Are Not Changing:

- 10% discount for seniors 62 years of age or older;
- Free home compost bins upon request (you'll now get these delivered free of charge as well);
- Trash cart valet service upon request (free for disabled households);
- Free bulky item pick up two times a year (now with up to 6 items per year instead of 2 per pickup);
- Monthly household hazardous waste collection upon request.

New Services Being Proposed:

- Recycling and organic waste (food and green waste) collection to every account;
- 10% discount for low-income households;
- New waste carts to all households as well as new organic waste carts as required by State law;
- Free mulch and compost giveaways twice a year;
- Free annual curbside holiday tree collection (cutting of trees no longer required);
- Free paper shredding events twice a year;
- Free local landfill days three times a year.

IMPACT TO YOU:

The proposed agreement introduces consistent rates for all residential customers with similar service levels while complying with new State laws. As such, your waste collection rates will be changing. For residential service, the proposed agreement will result in about 70% of households seeing a decrease in monthly waste collection bills. However, about 30% of households will see an increase that will be phased in over two years.

Commercial rates will have more variability due to the structuring of past service agreements. Commercial customers are encouraged to meet with WM representatives to discuss specific waste collection needs.
