


BUILDING D



At pad Building D, a new low stone wall highlights the driveway entry and wraps an outdoor patio at the corner of the building. Decorative wood pilasters and a clock tower are proposed, to add architectural character to this street front building. Improvements also include new metal canopies, exterior lighting, landscaping and new tenant signage.




1 - Existing East Elevation




3 - Existing West Elevation









Sidewalk Plan




