## NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING

### PLANNED DEVELOPMENT PERMIT NO. 20-005

The City Council of the City of Westlake Village will conduct a public hearing to consider an application from SGH Architects, on behalf of SCI California Funeral Services, Inc. doing business as Pierce Brothers Valley Oaks Memorial Park, requesting approval of Planned Development Permit (PDP) No. 20-005, authorizing the addition of 5,540 sq. ft. to an existing crematorium facility, the installation of a new adjacent maintenance yard, and the relocation of an existing trash enclosure within the cemetery park, located at 5600 Lindero Canyon Road.

The Public Hearing will be held via teleconference, in accordance with Governor Newsom's Executive Order N-29-20, at 6:30 p.m., Wednesday, January 13, 2021 in the City Council Chambers located at 31200 Oak Crest Drive, Westlake Village, California. Testimony regarding the proposed project may be presented at that time.

The proposed project is exempt from the provisions of the California Environmental Quality Act. Challenges to the proposed project in court may be limited to only those issues raised at the public hearing described in this notice, or in written correspondence delivered to the City at, or prior to, the public hearing.
